## SVGA membership conditions

- Applicants must be over 55 years of age, hold membership at an affiliated Golf Club, and maintain a current Golf Australia handicap.
- An acceptable golf club is defined as a “bricks and mortar” club with a golf course. Social golf groups are not eligible.
- All games are played following the official rules of golf, and results are entered directly into Golf Australia.
- Members must adhere to any host club rules.
- Slow play must be avoided. The lowest marker in each group is responsible for ensuring the group keeps pace with those ahead.
- Members agree to be bound by the constitution and terms and Conditions of the Sydney Vets Golf Association
- Note: The Miscore app is used for all games.

## Dress Regulations

Members must comply with the dress code of the host club for all SVGA events. Dress codes are typically available on each club's website, with links accessible via the SVGA 1golf website. The minimum standard for SVGA events is as follows:

- Shirts: Collared shirts with sleeves are required. High crew neck collar shirts with a golf brand logo are also acceptable. Shirts must remain tucked in.
- Shorts/Trousers: Shorts and trousers must be tailored and knee-length. The following are not permitted unless bearing a golf brand logo: elastic waistbands, drawstrings, jeans, or cargo pants.
- Socks: Short, white, ankle-length socks are required. Golf club or golf brand logos are permitted.
- Shoes: Golf shoes with soft spikes are mandatory for play. In the clubhouse, boat shoes (without socks) or walking shoes with socks are acceptable. Thongs, Crocs, and sandals are not permitted.

If a member requires a variation to these dress rules for medical reasons, the committee will consider requests accompanied by a doctor's certificate.

## Mobile Telephones

The SVGA uses the Miscore scoring system, and members are strongly encouraged to use the app. Mobile phone usage on the golf course is limited to distance measurement and scoring via Miscore. Calls should only be made in case of an emergency. Members are responsible for checking each club's policy regarding mobile phone use in and around the clubhouse.
