SVGA 2025 Club Champion Michael O' Keefe Awarded the John Newberry Perpetual trophy



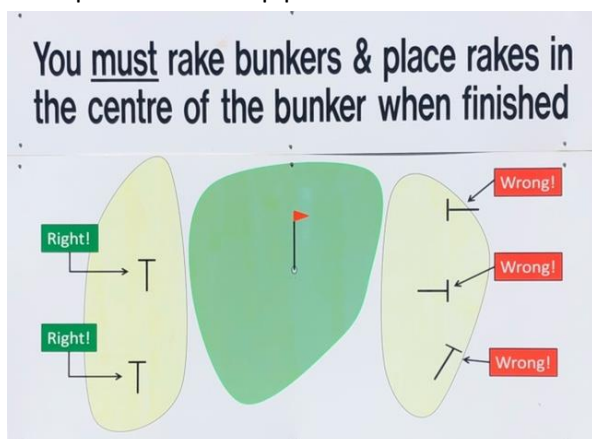

Q 1 A player plays their second shot, searches for the ball briefly and then goes back and drops another ball under penalty of stroke and distance. Before the player can play the dropped ball, the player's original ball is found within three minutes of when the player first started searching for it. *Which ball is to be played and is there any additional penalty?* **What is the ruling?**

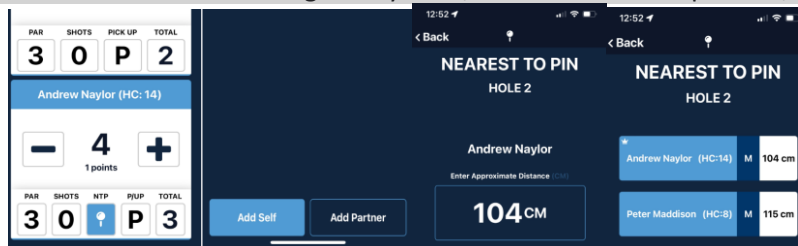
Q 2 Player B's ball was lying badly in deep rough. Player A said to player B: "You have no shot at all. If I were you, I would declare the ball unplayable." *Are there any penalties to be applied to player A or B?* **What is the ruling?**

Q 3 On the 17th hole, the player's tee shot comes to rest in a bunker. The player takes a practice swing in the bunker as they prepare for their next shot and hits the sand. The player makes their stroke and the ball finishes close to the hole. The player takes one more stroke to complete the hole. What is the player's score for the hole in stroke play? *What is the score to be entered - 3, 4 or 5?* **What is the ruling?**

Miscore - NTP, Menu items, what Tee should I be playing off?

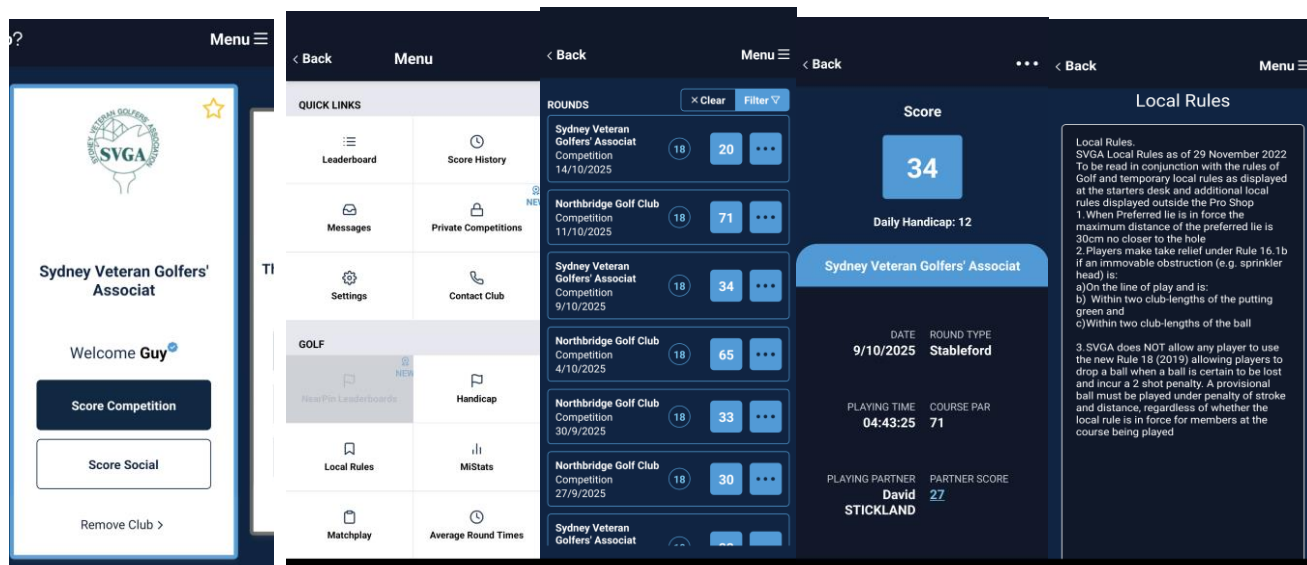
1. NTP - Select the flashing Tee symbol, select add self or partner, enter distance in cm



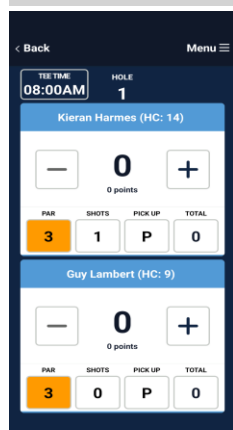
From Stonecutters #1 NTP will be only be entered using the function on the Miscore app. A tape measure will be available on the NTP holes. If you are using an Apple I phone there is a built in app called Measure. This works really well and is very accurate and handy on the golf course.

Caution - Before you hit enter, make sure the distance is in cm & is correct If you are 4 metres enter 400 not 40. Made a mistake? To delete the name & distance entered HARD PRESS i.e. hold your finger on the name and follow the prompts

2. Menu – **How many games have I played with SVGA?** - Top right of the Miscore SVGA app, select menu then select score history. You will see all your competition games. Select the 3 dots, this shows the venue, playing partner etc. Whilst you are on the Menu page have a look at the SVGA local rules.



3. Miscore Tee colour



SVGA games are played a number of courses with different colour Tee boxes in play. The booking sheet should indicate the colour and on the Miscore app when you have logged in, the colour should be displayed on the Par number – in this photo the Tee colour is orange. If in doubt ask someone what colour we are using on the day.

QUIZ ANSWERS

Q1 - The player must continue with the dropped ball. See [Rule 18.1](#). Once the player puts another ball in play under penalty of stroke and distance, the original ball is no longer in play and must not be played

Q2- As player A's advice could have influenced player B in determining his play, Player A gets two penalty strokes added to their score. Player B is not penalised. See [Rule 10.2a](#) and Clarification [Advice/1](#). Such a comment is advice because it could have influenced the player in deciding how to play the hole. https://www.randa.org/en/rog/the-rules-of-golf/rule-10#10_2a

Q3 - Before making a stroke at a ball in a bunker, a player must not touch sand in the bunker with a club in making a practice swing (see [Rule 12.2b](#)). Score should be 5 not 3 https://www.randa.org/en/rog/the-rules-of-golf/rule-12#12_2b
